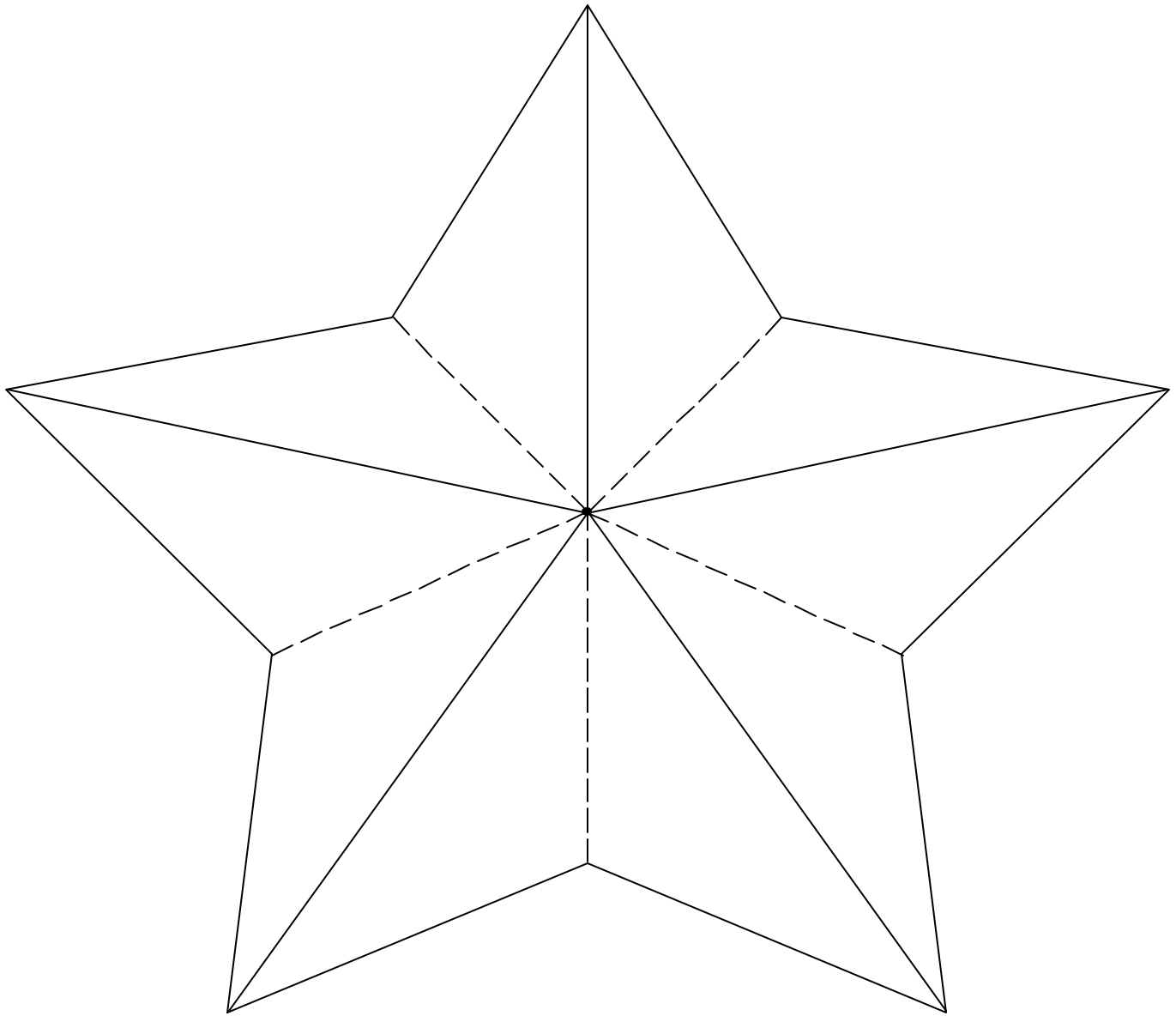


HOW TO MAKE 3D STARS



DIRECTIONS

To make 3D paper stars, print this template onto the back of decorative cardstock (you can reduce or enlarge the star designs when printing, if desired). Use a bone folder or the dull side of a butter knife and a ruler to score the paper from the center to the inside points and from the center to the outside points (solid lines on the template). Make valley folds (the crease moving away from you) along the dashed lines and mountain folds (the crease coming towards you) along the solid lines to make the star pop out.

You can also cut along all the lines and glue alternating pieces to another star, decorate with glitter, etc.

There's a definite top and bottom to these stars, so if they look strange, just rotate. Attach a hanger to the top and use as ornaments, string them onto a garland, or use them as present toppers.
